Instruction for Authors

- 1. Articles should be 4000 to 7000 words (including references and appendices).
- 2. Times New Roman in 12-point font size is to be followed. **1.15 spaces** must be there. The margin should be 1 inch on all sides on an A4 size. No need to mention page number.
- 3. For articles in the Nepali language, the author(s) need to use Unicode (Preeti, Kokila or other similar fonts) font style with 16-point font size.
- 4. APA 7th ed. style should be followed for intext citation, tables, figures, headings, sub-headings and referencing.
- 5. Tables, charts, and graphs should be numbered and visible in black and white.
- 6. If there is any **acknowledgment or declaration**, it should be mentioned before the references. Appendices should be placed after references. Please avoid long appendices.
- 7. Footnotes are not allowed.
- 8. Authors will be responsible for plagiarism. Plagiarized writing from any author might result in cancelling that particular author from submitting articles in this journal later on.
- 9. The article should be in MS Word file with at least 10 references.

Article format

- Title: Title of the article (no more than 15 words), with author's name and institutional affiliation.
- Abstract: 200-250 words (should include background, aim or purpose, method, results and conclusions/implications)
- **Keywords:** 4-6 keywords selected from discipline, theme, research design, method, and context (town, country, institution) of the study.
- **Introduction:** Clearly introduce the title with background, including topic or subject area, research problem or issue, rationale for the research problem, gap in the evidence, purpose of the study and relating discussion to audiences that will benefit from the study.
- Literature Review (theoretical and empirical)
- Methodology (including research design, sample and sampling techniques, tools and data collection procedures)
- Results and Discussion
- Conclusion with implications/suggestions of the study
- Acknowledgments (if any)
- References
- Appendices (if necessary)
- Author's short biography

Note: The general format of the article adopted by FWJE is Introduction, Methodology, Results and Discussion,

Conclusion (IMRDC) and literature review can be included in the Introduction section. There may be a slight variation in format depending on the nature of the article.
